Consider Modifications to the Junk Motor Vehicle Ordinance

As requested by the Committee at the previous meeting, the City Attorney drafted modifications to the existing ordinance. Brad Neighbor indicated that after reviewing the current ordinance, the State enabling legislation and discussing issues with the Code Compliance staff, he concluded that a complete rewrite of the ordinance was needed. Consequently, he prepared a draft of a new ordinance and stated that the ordinance clarified definitions and addressed various issues identified by Council members and staff. He articulated for the Committee the significant changes from the existing ordinance. After discussion, the Committee voted to move forward with proposed changes and asked that an item be placed on the March 22, 2010 for the Committee to report to the full Council.

<u>Discuss the Detroit Retaining Occupancy on Foreclosure (ROOF) Program</u> – Chairperson Cox asked that this item be postponed until the April meeting as she would be discussing this program with individuals from Detroit during the upcoming National League of Cities meeting and would have additional information at that time. The Committee voted to postpone the item until the April 6, 2010 meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
