WASH YOUR HANDS!

When to wash hands:

- 1. Immediately before preparing food
- 2. After using the restroom
- 3. After coughing, sneezing, blowing nose, eating, drinking or using tobacco
- 4. After handling soiled equipment or utensils
- 5. When changing from working with raw foods to ready-to-eat foods or a different type of raw food
- 6. After touching nose or mouth
- 7. Before putting on gloves or using hand sanitizer
